

Global Justice Committee

Terms of Reference

Revised January 2013
Approved by CUPE MB Executive

The Committee shall be known as the Global Justice Committee. We are a subordinate body of CUPE Manitoba and abide by their constitution and policies.

- 1. The purpose of the Committee shall be:
 - a) To develop awareness among CUPE members about the importance of building international links in the labour movement.
 - b) To promote CUPE's present international links (union to union, worker to worker) and to form new relationships, thereby working with our international brothers and sisters in the struggle against dismantling of work social and environmental standards in Canada and around the world.
 - c) To educate and promote the CUPE Global Justice Fund among CUPE Manitoba locals as a vehicle to continue CUPE's international work
- 2. The committee shall endeavor to meet monthly between September and June on preestablished dates to be confirmed at the committee's annual strategic planning session.
- 3. Membership on the committee shall be open to all CUPE locals affiliated to CUPE Manitoba.
- 4. The Co-chairs shall be elected by the committee. Elections will be held biannually at the first meeting in October.
- 5. The terms of office shall be two years.
- 6. The committee will endeavor to use a consensus based decision making process.
- 7. Committee members will be encouraged to apply to serve on the National Global Justice Committee
