ELECTRONIC VOTING UPDATE

NEWS

- The Provincial Government has issued a Request for Proposals ("RFP") or a tender for a contract to allow for electronic voting in the upcoming health care votes.
- According to the government documents, obtained by CUPE, the RFP will likely be awarded in early January, with votes in March or April.
- CUPE is sharing information with you as the process develops.

HOW DOES THIS AFFECT ME?

- The possibility for electronic voting means that voting for CUPE will be easier than ever.
- Make sure that your Employer has accurate contact information and visit cupehealthcare.ca to ensure you get the latest details on how to vote online.

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

- The dates of the votes and how to vote will be determined in consultation with the company chosen in January, so more details will likely follow early in the new year. CUPE will always share the latest information with you.

- CUPE has the lowest dues of any union representing support workers. Plus, we do not collect any dues on overtime or shift premiums. When you work tough shifts, or long hours, that's money in your pocket, not ours.
